Just an update on how things are progressing.

We have over 120 machines nominated to date. We now have machines from each decade. I have 5 machines from 1900 – 1910 tentatively nominated but I am waiting for the online or posted nomination form to come in. If you know anyone who has not submitted their nomination form, please ask them to get on it as soon as they can as it would be a pity if they missed out on participating in the Display.

Just asking again, *did you help with the last display*? If you can help again please contact me so we can start to arrange a roster of helpers for the event. If you have any skills you can bring to bear let me know.

I need some help with the preparation of the individual exhibit display placards. Did you help last time? If you did and can help again let us know. If you have nominated a machine please prepare some information about its history or the history of its manufacturer, so we can display it with your machine. Our goal is to Educate & inform the public about these wonderful machines.

We will be looking for volunteers to stay at the venue over night for added security. We have nominated an area on the mezzanine floor that overlooks the venue for this purpose. It should be a great experience & an opportunity for a long gas bag about Motorcycling Now and Then.

I was contacted by Dean Govern and Pud Freeman has advised he also has some display materials from previous displays he will bring along to help flesh out the exhibits.

Barry has put together a scale mockup of the Ace Café display and the Stage we are constructing for the guest speakers. I have arranged for the venue to be open at 10.00 am on Thursday August 11<sup>th</sup> at 10.00 am for the organizing Sub-committee to check it out & finalise the display area. We are also happy for exhibitors to come down for a look and share our vision of how the display will be laid out. Please take advantage of this if you can.

I would like to implore you to send in your formal nomination form or go online & fill in the Online Nomination Form. It is essential we have your acknowledgement of the Term & Conditions of being involved so we can proceed with selection of your machine. The sooner I have this the easier it is to arrange the layout & printing.

The form outlines the Terms & conditions and the limits on liability for the Club. As part of the sponsorship deal with Shannons we have included a survey on bike insurance. *Please fill it in & help us out. Jeff Hughes from Shannons has been very helpful so this is a little payback for their support.* 

The information will only be forwarded on if you ask for a competitive Insurance quote. By the way if you already have insurance with Shannons (or others probably) you are covered for this event.

We have managed to secure dedicated motorcycle parking outside the venue in Mundy Street.

I am waiting to hear from other clubs interested in using the "Classics at Hart" as their ride destination in October. If you are a member of multiple Clubs please spread the word! As the more people who are aware of the Display the greater success it will be.
