

Ride to the Barossa Valley

Wednesday 7th October 2020

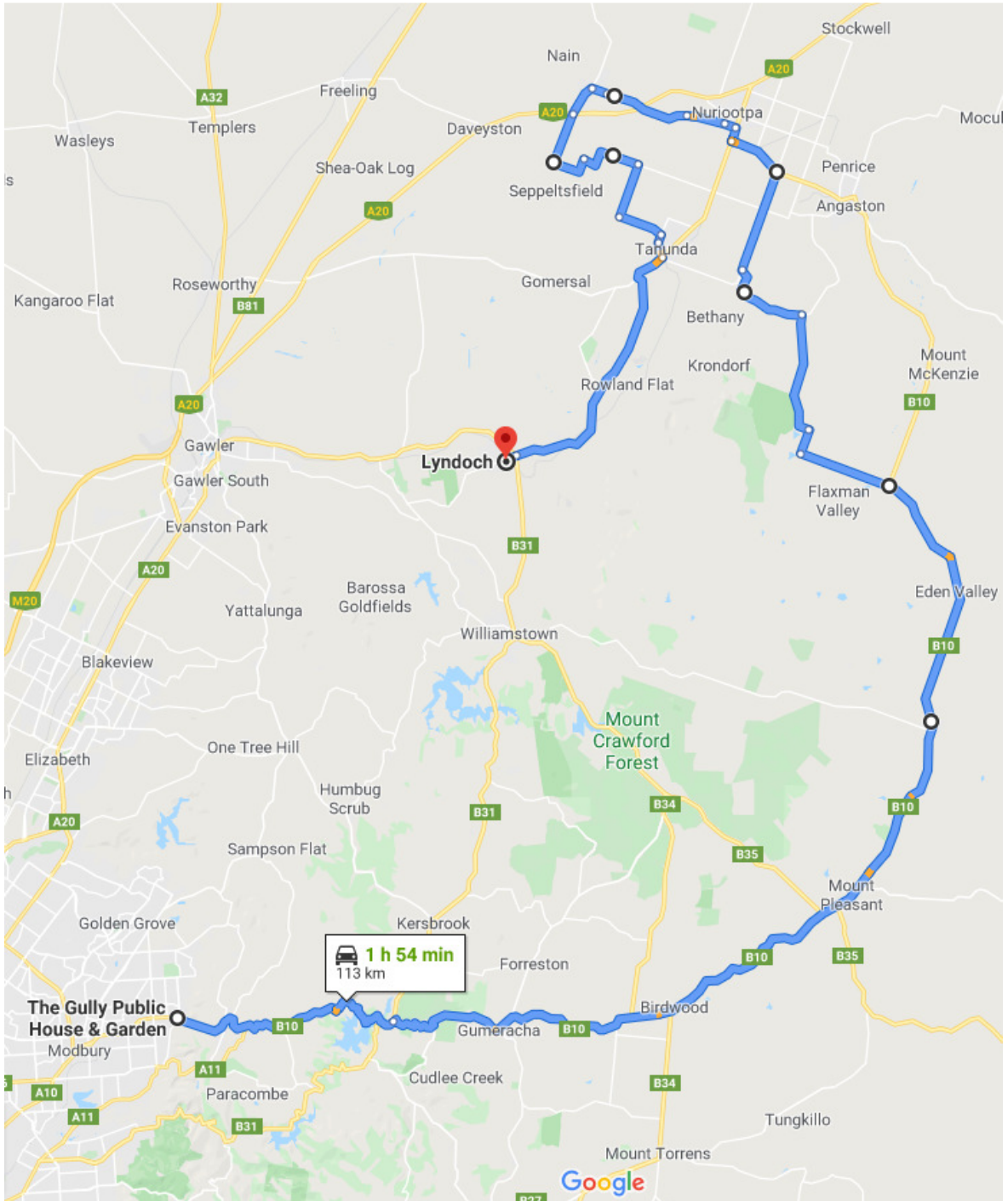


Morning tea at the Mount Pleasant Bakery and lunch at the Lyndoch Bakery and Restaurant. Meet in the Tea Tree Gully Hotel car park 1349 North East Rd at 8:30 am for 9 am start. All makes and models of motorcycles welcome.

Our route in the morning will take us up through the Adelaide Hills to Mount Pleasant via Chain of Ponds, Gumeracha and Birdwood for a regroup and morning tea break at the Bakery. After the break we will travel via Springton and Eden Valley to the Barossa Sculpture park and lookout at Menglers Hill. From here we will tour the Valley proper via Bethany, Angaston, Nuriootpa, Greenock, Seppeltsfield and Tanunda before arriving in Lyndoch for a well earned lunch. Approximate distance 113 km.

After lunch we will travel through Cockatoo Valley with a scenic stop at the "Whispering Wall". Then on through Para Wirra Conservation Park, Humbug Scrub and Snake Gully, back down into the suburbs at Golden Grove and then return to our starting point at Tea Tree Gully. Distance 44 km.
